- Life science education for students, beginning at the high school level.
- Professional development for high school, community college and four year college and university instructors.
- Programs that are broad in scope and reach students and/or educators from a variety of geographic locations are preferred.
- Special consideration is also given to programs that target groups traditionally underrepresented in the life sciences, including but not limited to women and diverse populations.

Through science community involvement, ADInstruments also seeks to increase access to fundamental laboratory skills and knowledge that further basic research efforts in academia and the private sector. Programs and initiatives that address these objectives are preferred:

- Hands-on technique-focused educational events.
- Regional scientific meetings with a priority given to presentation and collaboration of current research findings.
- Individuals or research groups that provide novel scientific discussion to participants at large.
- Special consideration is also given to programs that have a global dimension.
